Here are some options to consider:

Routine Maintenance

Ordinarily, PRO-MIC Systems are returned to our shop for repair and calibration at 6 or 12 month intervals.

We return the system to "as new" condition - and prove it by conducting a repeatability study of the whole system on our test roll before returning it to you.

This way, you know it is ready to return to service in your shop.

Short Term Rentals

These units are available as short term maintenance rental systems to keep your shop in action while your PRO-MIC is serviced.

On Site Maintenance
